Application Materials For CAPA, Honors, Paula A. Santen Scholarship & Track 2: Advanced Specialization

Portfolio

Digital portfolio of 12 single image files (Jpegs < 2 MB each), consisting of work from studio courses at the university (or other higher education institutions). Select artwork carefully. The portfolio should emphasize complete work and include some variety, without sacrificing overall quality. Photos should be clear, in focus, and of ample resolution. If submitting time-based or interactive work, upload one representative still image and include a YouTube, Vimeo or other online link. Please include the following information for each image: one-sentence description, media, creation date and dimensions.

Unofficial transcript in PDF format.

For CAPA applicants: (only)

Names of 2 Art Faculty with Whom You've Worked and Who Could Serve as References (No need to contact faculty for permission.)

Extracurricular Activities (one or two paragraphs)

For Honors applicants: (only)

A brief cover letter to the honors director indicating your desire to be considered for the Honors Program.

Paula A. Santen Applicants: (only)

Provide a cover letter no longer than one page that includes a statement of financial need.

Track 2: Advanced Specialization (only)

Letter to Undergraduate Director Wendy Jacobs

Applications that do not include all of these components are incomplete and will not be considered. **Applications must be submitted by 4:00 p.m. on April 8.** No exceptions will be made.
